

2397- RPL matrix (recognition of prior learning)

Notes for centres

- 1) Before registering learners, an assessment should be made to the suitability of any individual wishing to register on the full complex (2397-30) or the single unit complex (2397-31).
- 2) Learners with 24 months or more documented experience in installing and commissioning Electrotechnical equipment in dwellings may register on the single unit complex.
- 3) Learners wishing to register on the single complex route must fulfil the criteria for RPL as set out in the single complex knowledge evidence section.
- 4) Any candidate with 24 months or more experience who cannot fulfil all of the criteria set out on the single complex route must register on the RPL complex
- 5) Any candidate who has less than 24 months experience must register on the full complex.
- 6) The complex for learners wishing to RPL their knowledge will be available soon
